Request form

May we remind operators to continue to use the updated PAS 100 Compost Analysis Request Form. This is to be used when sending compost samples to the Approved Laboratories for certification. Applicants and operators are required to use this form under the CCS. There are now fields that indicate the type of sample being sent for testing and the purpose of analysis.

Additionally, the 'certification code' field must be populated with a valid certification code, for test results to be accepted. The updated PAS 100 Compost Analysis Request Form can be found <u>here</u>. Please use this form for all samples sent for certification purposes going forward.

CCS position on technical requirements

Operators are also reminded that the CCS Position on Technical Requirements document was also updated earlier this year. The purpose of the document is to provide clarity on specific technical requirements within the scheme documents and ensure consistency in the interpretation of these requirements.
