Sample Labelling Guidance

REAL have updated the CCS guidance on how to label a PAS 100 sample and prepare the relevant paperwork. The guidance has been updated to support applicants who may not be familiar with the scheme requirements, particularly around the need to request temporary certification details before testing. Additionally, some updates were made to the text to reflect more recent changes to the scheme.
